Special Mentions

Please note this is a maximum of two adults per child due to our hall capacity.

Friday Open Mornings

Each class will be open to parents on a Friday morning. This will allow you to see the classroom environment and for your child to share some of their learning with you.

Please help us by leaving your child's class when asked by the teacher. This is to enable the teacher to take the register at the correct time (08:30 in KS1 and 8:50 at KS2) and get the children ready. If you are attending our Special Mention Assembly you can then make your way to the hall and leave by the main entrance at the end.

School vision

Over the next couple of weeks we will be launching our new school vision with our children. When developing our vision, I really wanted it to be easy to understand and meaningful. During INSET training, staff looked closely at the church of England's vision for education and carefully considered what we want for the children at Brampton Ellis. Our new vision is as follows:
